

Reno High School Triple A Scholarships

Each spring the Reno High School Triple A Club awards scholarships in several areas. Scholarships are presented to students for achievement in the areas of: academics, arts, athletics, journalism, vocational and volunteerism. An Outstanding Senior Scholarship for overall achievement is also given. Achievement in a given area, personal character and financial needs are all considered in the selection process.

Eligibility Requirements:

1. You must be a Reno High School senior eligible for graduation in June 2010.
2. You must be planning to attend a university, junior college, community college or vocational/technical school or program upon graduation.
3. You must have a cumulative grade point average of 2.5 or higher (unweighted).

Application Guidelines:

1. **The application may be retrieved on the Reno High School website at www.rhshuskies.com.** Use the link on the top, AAA, and Scholarship Instructions. This application is an MS Word document. **[Click on the GO TO APPLICATION box at the bottom of these instructions to retrieve the file.](#)** Follow the instructions in item 7 to submit your application.
2. Completed applications must be submitted to the Career Center by **Thursday, January 7, 2010, at 8:00 A.M.** **Those that are received after the deadline will not be accepted and will be returned unopened. There will be no exceptions!**
3. Applications must be typed or printed legibly in black ink. The application may be reproduced using your computer but the application must not be changed in any way.
4. The panel of selectors will consist of representatives from the RHS Triple A Scholarship Committee.
5. Eligible students may apply for more than one Triple A Scholarship.
6. Scholarships may not be awarded if qualified students do not apply. This decision is made at the discretion of the RHS Triple A Club Scholarship Committee.
7. To complete the application process, please submit seven (7) applications (one original + 6 copies) of:
 - a. Pages 2-6 of this application package.
 - b. Your RHS transcript showing the first **six** semesters (one original and 6 copies).
 - d. **Please collate, three-hole punch and staple all seven sets of your application.**

IF YOU ARE APPLYING FOR MORE THAN ONE SCHOLARSHIP, please photocopy a set of seven for each category (ie. if you apply for 2 scholarships submit 7 applications for each one, 14 total applications).

Scholarships will be awarded in these categories using the following criteria:

Academic (two scholarships each for \$1,000; one male and one female recipient): The recipient will have a distinguished academic history at RHS. GPA, SAT and ACT test scores, difficulty of course curriculum, personal statement and essay will be considered.

Arts (two scholarships each for \$1,000; one male and one female recipient): The recipient will have a distinguished record in either the performing arts or studio arts at RHS or outside of school. Performance by the applicant in his or her particular area, personal statement and essay will be considered. Actors/Actresses: submit a video tape showing two (2) different scenes. Musician/Singers: submit audiotape with two (2) selections. **Limit audio and video tapes to 3 minutes total for both scenes/selections.** Artists: submit 3 pieces of artwork of at least two (2) different mediums. **Art must be dropped off between 7:30 and 8:00 a.m. Thursday, January 7, 2010, in the RHS College and Career Center, and picked up by the end of the day on Friday, January 8, 2010.**

Athletics (two scholarships each for \$1,000; one male and one female recipient): The recipients will have a distinguished athletic career at RHS and outside of school. Athletic achievement, sportsmanship, personal statement and essay will be considered.

Journalism (one scholarship for \$1,000): The recipient will have a distinguished record in Journalism classes and activities at RHS and outside of school. The variety of Journalism classes, personal statement and essay will be considered.

Vocational (one scholarship for \$1,000): The recipient will have a distinguished record in vocational classes and activities at RHS and outside of school. The variety of vocational classes, personal statement and essay will be considered. This scholarship will be awarded to a student planning to attend a technical or a vocational program or school.

Outstanding Senior (two scholarships for \$1,000; one male and one female recipient): The recipient will have participated in a wide variety of RHS activities and distinguished himself or herself in these activities. GPA, course curriculum, activities at RHS, activities outside of school, a personal statement and essay will be considered.
